ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the court on January 23, 2008, for a status and scheduling conference to address case management issues in preparation for reconvening the hearing on State Farm's motion for preliminary injunction. See docket entry [79]. The court having considered the positions of the parties and being fully advised in the premises orders as follows:

1. All parties shall supplement initial disclosures on or before January 31, 2008;
2. The order [57] directing the defendant to appear and testify at the reconvened hearing remains in effect;
3. State Farm's *ore tenus* motion for leave to take the deposition of Richard Scruggs for use at the hearing is granted as this witness may be outside of the subpoena power of this court and, therefore, may not be available to testify live at the hearing;
4. A separate order addressing the time, place and scope of the hearing shall be entered by the District Judge.
